**Tim Costello**

Since commencing as CEO of World Vision Australia in early 2004, Tim Costello has established a strong public presence in the fight against global poverty. Prior to this, he led many debates on tough domestic social justice issues including gambling, urban poverty, homelessness, reconciliation and substance abuse. Through his ministry at Melbourne's Collins St Baptist Church, he ran Urban Seed – a not-for-profit organisation that provides outreach and hospitality services to the urban poor. He was also a significant social advocate in his joint role as minister and lawyer at St Kilda Baptist Church between 1986-1994. He was elected mayor of St Kilda in 1993 and in July 2004 Tim was awarded "Victorian of the Year".
