DIOCESAN CHILDREN'S HOMES ORDINANCE 1977

BE IT ENACTED by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Tasmania in Synod assembled as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diocesan Children's Homes Ordinance 1977.
2. The Diocesan Children's Homes Ordinance, 1960 is hereby repealed.
3. This Ordinance shall apply to:-
 - (i) The Clarendon Children's Home at Kingston Beach,
 - (ii) The Roland Boys' Home at Sheffield, and
 - (iii) such other homes, if any, as Synod may establish or maintain in addition to, or in substitution for, such homes as aforesaid, or any of them and the expression "The Home" used in this Ordinance shall apply to all or any of such homes as that context may require.
4. The Objects of the Home shall be to provide for the entire welfare of children who from time to time are living in the Home and where practicable to assist with the continuance of that welfare in the years immediately following their exit from residence.
5. The Constitution, Rules and By-Laws of any Home or any alteration thereto shall be subject to the approval of the Diocesan Council.
6. Subject to the approval of the Diocesan Council it shall be lawful for any Home to be Incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act, 1964, of the State of Tasmania.
7.
 - (i) Any property held for the purpose of the Home shall be vested in the Trustees of the Diocese of Tasmania.
 - (ii) All capital funds, bequests and reserve funds shall be invested with the Trustees of the Diocese of Tasmania.
 - (iii) No capital monies shall be expended for the purpose of the Home except with the approval of the Diocesan Council and under such terms and conditions as it determines.
