

## **ANGLICAN CHURCH OF AUSTRALIA - DIOCESE OF TASMANIA**

### **DIOCESAN OFFICERS' APPOINTMENT ORDINANCE 1959**

BE IT ENACTED by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Anglican Church of Australia in Tasmania in Synod assembled as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diocesan Officers Appointment Ordinance 1959.
2. Synod shall, by resolution, appoint a person as and to be Treasurer of the Diocese who shall hold his office during pleasure and shall be called the Diocesan Treasurer.
3. If any vacancy occurs in the office of Diocesan Treasurer whilst the Synod is not sitting the Diocesan Council may appoint a person as and to be the Diocesan Treasurer until the next meeting of the Synod.
4. The persons holding for the time being the respective offices of Church Advocate, Chancellor of the Diocese, Diocesan Treasurer, Diocesan Secretary and Diocesan Ministry Officer shall be ex-officio members of Synod and shall, unless otherwise qualified, be summoned to the Synod by the Bishop as if they were lay representatives of the Diocese.

5. Sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Diocesan Council Ordinance is amended by adding a new paragraph VI A as follows:- "VI A - The Diocesan Treasurer".
